Ms. Mckinney said she have a response on the comptroller's report. JPD does have a good solid plan in place quarterly. They will have many audits here on out, to make sure the process is being followed. She will report out the entire audit next month.

Chairman Taylor said we don't have any budget amendments this month. Last month we did vote to recommend those budget amendments to come through this committee moving forward.

**Report**: Mr. Arnold said in this current year FY22 we had quite a bit of activity. With drawing from fund balance up to revenue, transferring funds, or expense funds which make the variances look unusual. Budget summary is at 18.7 million in revenue. 78.1 million next year with a 1% increase. On the expense side will be street resurfacing and the industrial land purchase. There was further discussion concerning the reappraisal for property taxes and the certified tax rate that will take place.
